CLASSES IN THE SHOW:

- **Baby** – 4-6 months
- **Puppy** – 6-9 months
- **Junior** – 9-18 months
- **Intermediate** – 15-24 months
- **Open** – from 15 months
- **Working** – from 15 months (FCI working certificate should be enclosed when entering)
- **Champion** – from 15 months (national / international champion certificate should be enclosed when entering)
- **Veteran** – from 8 years

TITLES AWARDED AT THE SHOW:

- **LT CAC** – Challenge Certificate for the Lithuanian Champion
- **Kl. JN** – Club Junior Winner
- **Kl. N** – Club Winner
- **Kl. VN** – Club Veteran Winner
- **BOS** – Best of Opposite Sex
- **BOB** – Best of Breed

COMPETITIONS:

- Dogs taking part in competitions must be entered to the show in one of these classes: junior, intermediate, open, working, champion or veteran. Dogs that received qualifications „disqualified“ or „cannot be judged“ in the breed ring cannot take part in the competitions.
- Brace competition – two dogs (male and female) of the same breed owned by the same person.
- Breeders group – at least three dogs of the same breed, bred by the same breeder, from at least two different litters.
- Progeny competition – male / female with at least three of his/her offsprings, from at least two different litters.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- The entrant / exhibitor declares that every dog entered has been adequately vaccinated (standard vaccinations, the validation of the vaccination in accordance with the vaccine's producer advise) of which proof can be shown. Dogs coming from abroad are required to have been vaccinated against rabies and distemper which must be recorded in a European pet passport. If the dog is vaccinated for the first time or if the term of previous revaccination has expired, at least 21 days should have passed since the latest vaccination to the show day.
- All the dogs must be identified with a microchip or a clearly readable tattoo.
- If unforeseen circumstances occur, the show committee reserves the right to change the judge.
- Dogs and classes entered cannot be changed. Entry fee can only be refunded in case of cancellation of the show or death of the dog.
